



Student Acceptable Use/Responsibility Agreement for Technology Devices

I understand and will abide by the provisions and conditions of this agreement. I understand that any violations of these provisions may result in disciplinary action, the revoking of my technology access privileges, and appropriate legal actions.

As the parent or guardian of this student, I have read, discussed with my student, and agree to the provisions of this agreement. I understand that it is impossible for the Vista Unified School District to restrict access to all controversial or inappropriate materials, and I will not hold the District responsible for materials acquired at school or at home.

I also give my permission for my student to access teacher facilitated web sites that require parental approval as part of the Children Internet Protection Act (CIPA). I also acknowledge that I am financially responsible to replace any district owned electronic device provided to my student should there be a loss, theft, or malicious damage.

VUSD has chosen to provide **optional** Mobile Device Cost Protection Plan (MDCPP) for school issued mobile devices given to students for their academic use. Coverage will protect the device against ACCIDENTAL DAMAGE, THEFT, FIRE, FLOOD, NATURAL DISASTERS, and POWER SURGE. This coverage will provide full replacement cost of the device (not the case or charger/cord) and protect the item on and off school grounds. The coverage is also transferable to a replacement unit.

MDCPP coverage is valid ONLY for the school year (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020). The MDCPP is \$20 per device.

It can be purchased online using a credit card (during online registration process or on RBV website) or at the Finance Office during Registration or prior to August 31, 2019.

MDCPP coverage is optional, but highly recommended. If I choose not to purchase MDCPP coverage, I understand that I am financially responsible for loss or damage to the device.
